

Sligo County Library User Policy has been created to protect the rights and safety of Library members, staff and for preserving and protecting the library's materials, equipment and facilities. Quiet and co-operative behaviour is expected at all times.

The Libraries patrons are expected to:

- Refrain from disruptive behaviour. Disruptive behaviour includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - Assault or intimidation of Library staff or patrons through language or actions
 - Any behaviour that creates excessive noise or commotion
 - Refusing to leave a Library unit at closing time
 - Entering areas of the library marked Staff Only
 - Being under the influence of alcohol/illegal drugs
- Refrain from marking materials with pencil, ink, tape, paper clips and/or bending corners of pages.
- Refrain from ripping or cutting pages out of materials. Please make copies instead.
- Refrain from eating food/drinking and/or using tobacco products in the library.
- Treat library staff and other library users with courtesy and respect.
- Refrain from using mobile telephones for phone calls or any other type of electronic device for voice communications
- Refrain from taking materials out of the library without first checking them out.
- Library materials and/or furniture must not be damaged or defaced in any way.

The Library operates a Zero Tolerance Policy.

Note: Anyone engaging in disruptive behaviour may be denied further access to the Libraries.
